ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
QUILCENE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the undersigned E. A. Dahman, Noah Johnston, Ray F. Ward, Ray R. Buchmann, Phyllis F. Caughill, D. R. Corley, Julian T. Oen, Harry O. Pritchard and Maurice L. Anderson, each being of full age and a citizen of the United States, have associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and in pursuance thereof do hereby sign and acknowledge the following articles of incorporation in triplicate originals, and do state as follows:

I

That the corporate name of this corporation shall be QUILCENE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To provide fire protection for property within the Quilcene area of Jefferson County, Washington, and to provide ambulance service for said area;

In the name aforesaid, to sue and be sued in any court;

To make and use a common seal and alter the same at pleasure;

To receive gifts and devises;

To purchase, hold, and convey real and personal property, as the purposes of the corporation may require;

To appoint such subordinate agents or officers as the business may require;

To demand assessments of members and sell and forfeit their interests in the corporation for default with respect to any lawful provision of the by-laws;

1 To enter into lawful contracts and incur obligations essential to
2 the transaction of the affairs of the corporation;

3 To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness, and to mortgage
4 the property of the corporation as security;

5 And generally, to do all things necessary and proper to carry out
6 the purposes of the creation.

7 III

8 That this corporation shall continue perpetually.

9 IV

10 That the location and post office address of this corporation shall
11 be Quilcene, Jefferson County, Washington.

12 V

13 That the number of trustees of this corporation shall be not less
14 than three nor more than five; that the number, qualifications, term of
15 office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and the powers
16 and duties of the trustees shall be such as are prescribed by the by-
17 laws of this corporation; that the names and addresses of the first
18 trustees who shall hold office and manage the affairs of the corpora-
19 tion for a period of not more than six months after the incorpora-
20 tion are as follows:
