

## AFFIDAVIT OF LOSS

Pursuant to Section 39.72.010 RCW, in case of the loss or destruction of a warrant for the payment of money issued by the district, the district may issue or cause to be issued a duplicate in lieu thereof, bearing the same designation and for the same amount as the original. Before a duplicate is issued, the issuing officer shall require the person making application for issuance of the duplicate to file a written affidavit specifically alleging on with a state of the average and a state of the average and the average an

- oath: That the applicant is the proper owner, payee, or legal representative of the owner or payee of the original instrument;
  - The date of issue, number, amount, and for what services, claim, or purpose the original instrument or series of instruments of which it is a
    part was issued;
  - That the original instrument has been lost or destroyed; and
  - That the original instrument has not been paid or has not been received by the applicant.

In the event that an original instrument and its duplicate instrument are both presented for payment as a result of forgery or fraud, the district shall endeavor to recover any losses suffered by the district.
